“What Can God do in 2022?” This was a statement that I mentioned in our last prayer letter. So far, 2022 has been amazing! We’ve maintained a packed calendar throughout these last couple of months, even filling some last-minute cancellations. We’ve been able to gain some new supporters and do some fundraising for a unique project. God is on the move here in New England, and we are thrilled to be a part of it! **Please note the new contact phone number on this letter.**

Family: January and February saw us getting much more snow. It was fine with us, especially the kids, as it gave them some outside time to try out new snow toys and even some inside time to play the new games they had gotten for Christmas. God provided the opportunity for Hannah and I to go to a marriage retreat in February thru the generous gifts of anonymous donors. It was a great time just to get away, even if we were only an hour from home, without the kids, and just enjoy each other. Thank you to those who gave towards that. God provided a way for Titus to be able to start karate classes recently. He loves it and already excelling in it. Savannah is continuing to learn her colors, shapes, and her alphabet. She constantly amazes me with how much she is learning and how quickly she is learning.

Ministry: Since our last letter, God has been on the move! He is opening doors for us that only He can! When I wrote our previous letter, we were in two schools and three prisons. Since writing that letter, **the Lord has allowed us to add one more school, with a fourth possibly happening before the end of the school year. We have gained access to facilities in Maine and are working closely with a chaplain to schedule a prison revival here in New England! God isn’t done here in New England!** I would like to mention one notable thing to you before I close this letter. Last year we did a Correctional Officer Appreciation event in May. We were able to impact over 500 COs by giving them a treat bag and a CO New Testament. When planning for this

year, I began asking God what He would like us to do for National Correctional Officer Week. I believe that we are supposed to do something much bigger. You may have seen my video on our Facebook page (The Frank Family (Rock of Ages)) about this event.

We are having a custom Challenge Coin minted and feeding at least the correctional officers, in our immediate area, a meal. In our immediate area alone, there is approximately 500 COs. There are about 14,000 COs in New England! **If we order 1,000 of them, the challenge coins are \$3.75 each. This, coupled with a meal, will cost approximately \$5,000. The Lord has allowed us to raise over \$2,900 of this needed money already. With COs having a 39% higher rate of suicide than any other profession out there, I want to do everything possible to reach them.** This event is designed in such a way that I pray that it will be a door opener to reach the CO while reaching the inmate. Prison ministry isn’t just reaching the inmate, but it’s reaching the CO as well. Will you pray about what God would have you personally or corporately do to help with this project? **If you want to get involved, you can send any funds into Rock of Ages and memo it for New England Account.** This event will be from May 1 – May 7. Even if you cannot contribute financially, would you please pray that God would use this event and others that we have planned throughout this year? **If your church would like to donate toward this project, we are asking that the money be sent by the end of April so we can purchase the items necessary to make this event a success.** We want to be a great representation of Christ to each CO that will be part of this event. What can God do in 2022? Thank you to all who support us prayerfully and financially each month. If your church doesn’t support us financially each month, would you prayerfully consider partnering with us financially each month as we do what we can to reach New England for Christ?
