“It costs the same to dream big as it does to dream little.” I heard a preacher make this statement several years ago, and while it does cost more to do big things, it truly doesn’t cost any more to dream big. Such is the case with what we have watched the Lord do these last few months. In November 2021, I began praying and asking the Lord what He would have us do for National Corrections Professional week in May 2022. I felt like we needed to do something big to significantly impact the Corrections Professionals here in New England, especially in the facilities where the Lord has opened the doors for me to be able to be there regularly. So, in January 2022, we started out raising money. We started with a goal of \$5,000. I quickly realized that due to increasing food costs, we would need to increase our original goal to \$8,000. With the increase in budget and God sending in the funds, we were able to impact over 800 corrections professionals lives. We serve the God of all Gods. The God we serve owns the cattle on a thousand hills and even the taters under the hills. \$8,000 was nothing to Him. He sent in the money by the end of April. We were able to get the challenge coins here in time and purchase all the food needed. In addition to the food and challenge coin, each officer received a gospel tract customized just for this event. The response has been excellent, even hearing from some of the ranking officers thanking us for what we provided.

Family: Titus is done with school for the year! He finished his last tests in April and has completed all the requirements for 2nd grade! Now for some field trip days and learning experiences at some incredible places here in New England. Savannah is happy to have her brother back to play with all the time now. Even without any kind of “formal education,” she is coming along with her writing and letter recognition. Lord willing, she will start at least pre-k this coming school year. Hannah and Titus will be starting piano lessons

again in June as we have found another piano teacher in town.

Ministry: March, April, and now into May, I have been extremely busy getting things together for Corrections Professional week, deputation meetings, and working the facilities that the Lord has allowed me to gain access to. As of the writing of this letter, I have three facilities that I work at each week, two that I work at least once a month with meetings lined up in the weeks to come to begin working with other facilities as well as getting local churches involved in their county jails and local prisons. One of these facilities has opened to us because of preparing for Corrections Professional week. I get to work the facility every Wednesday all day now. Thank the Lord for the open doors! Looking ahead, I will be taking a quick trip down to Chattanooga to attend our Annual Coordinators Conference, hosted by Lupton Drive Baptist Church. This is allowing me to get some training and to report in at two supporting churches and be in three new churches with the potential to pick up new support. We are prayerfully pushing to be at 100% by the time school starts back so I can concentrate my efforts here in New England to gain and train new volunteers instead of pursuing monthly support still. During the month of June, the Lord has provided me the opportunity to attend a Law Enforcement Chaplain training which will better equip me to minister not just to the inmate but also to the CO. Thank you for all your prayers and financial support! We could not do what we do without each of our supporters, whether prayerful or financial!
