**“They don’t love the prison; they love us.”** These are the words that an inmate stated in service in June. I was in a state prison with my pastor, and right before opening the service in prayer, he was encouraging the men to pay attention and be respectful. While doing so, he made that statement. That has stuck in my mind ever since then. I don’t necessarily care for the prison, if I’m being 100% honest, but I do love the inmates and staff behind the walls. Most of the time, there is a particular smell that lingers in the air, typically always loud noises bouncing off the concrete block walls making it seem that much louder, and other things that could be described. But I love it because God has given me a love for the inmate. The verse that rings in my ears over and over again is Matthew 25:40, where Jesus said: “And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.” It always excites me to be able to go to prison or jail and hold a Bible study or preach a message. There is joy in serving Jesus! If you would like to come to see what it’s like behind the walls and get involved in doing it unto the least of these, please don’t hesitate to reach out! I’d love to take you in for a service!

**Family:** Titus & Savannah are loving summer in New England. We’ve had a few days where it was above 90 degrees, but most days are in the 70s and 80s. Titus just earned his first belt in karate. To say he was excited about it would be an understatement. Titus and Hannah have started back to piano lessons after pausing to finish school. We also were able to find a piano teacher closer to home. Continue to pray for Titus and Savannah’s salvation. We pray every night that God would save

them at an early age and that they would fall in love with Jesus and serve Him the rest of their days in whatever aspect of ministry He places them in.

**Ministry:** May and June were extremely busy with different meetings that I was able to participate in. The Lord allowed me to preach or hold a bible study 25+ times during these two months. We currently have three facilities that I am in each week, with two more that are once a month. Two more facilities were supposed to be added but have temporarily been put on hold on the facility side. During May, I was privileged to travel down for our Coordinators Conference held at the Lupton Drive Baptist Church in Chattanooga, TN. They were a tremendous blessing in hosting this Conference for us and allowing us to use their facilities and even feed us while we were there. Traveling down allowed me to report back to some of our supporting churches and be in some new churches. During June, the Lord allowed me the opportunity to attend a Law Enforcement Chaplaincy training to gain some further training on how to minister to the Corrections Professionals that I get to work with regularly. Then towards the end of the month, we were able to be a part of helping our home church with their booth at Market Days here in Concord, NH. We were able to be a part of giving out 1,000 frisbees, 1,000 water bottles, and over 1,400 gospel tracts. Each frisbee and water bottle had verses printed on them telling of the love of Jesus. We are thankful to have a small part in helping our home church reach Concord, NH, for Christ. As I close, let me again thank you for your faithful financial support of my family and I. We could not do what we do without the faithful prayers and financial support of God’s people. If you do not currently support us financially each month, would you earnestly pray about partnering with us as we reach the prisoner and student with the Gospel!
