2 Corinthians 4:5

For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.

“Pray for those of us who are seeking.” This is the prayer request that an inmate gave recently in a service I was in. I was reminded of Matthew 7:8, where Jesus said, “For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.” So often, I come in contact with inmates seeking the truth; even though they may not say those exact words, that is what they are doing. My family and I have the honor of sharing the truth with them. **“Pray for the angry Christians”** This is another prayer request that I received recently. Inmates are people. They deal with the same struggles, problems, and everything else that you and I deal with. The difference is they don’t have the support system that we have many times, and as a result, they become angry at others, themselves, and yes, even God. I’m reminded of Psalm 147:3, where the Psalmist said, “He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.” I love what the Lord has called us to do here in New England and count it an honor to minister to the incarcerated men and women.

Family: By the time many of you receive this letter, the school year will be over for the Frank family, at least as far as classroom time is concerned. Hannah and the kids will be doing several things outside now that the weather has begun to improve here in New England. Gone are the blistering cold days of winter! Spring has sprung here in New England! Timothy is continuing to grow as he should. He weighs almost 13 pounds now and is starting to smile at you regularly, in addition to making cooing noises and laughing occasionally. Titus and Savannah are smitten with him, often having “competitions to see who can make him smile the most. He has been a blessing to us in these short few weeks (9 weeks old as of April 30). Pray for us as we continue to raise our children to live for the Lord and teach them right from wrong.

Ministry: What a busy few weeks since our last letter. Since our last letter, I have gained access to another prison in Maine. This one is the central prison located in Warren, ME. The new chaplain is excited about me being there. We will begin teaching the CUC lessons there and use the Bible while doing so. I was cautious in explaining that it is a Bible-based program.

She is welcoming us into the facility once a month, to begin with. Praise the Lord for open doors. I recently submitted my application to the Vermont Department of Corrections as well. It seems that the entire state of VT may be open to me coming in and doing Bible studies and religious services there. I am supposed to be doing the training for them the first week of May. Exciting times! On April 21-22, 2023, we were privileged to hold a prison revival at one of the state prisons here in NH. God blessed mightily during the meeting. We had a total of 15 messages preached, eight different volunteers (with some of them coming from as far away as Pennsylvania), and we were blessed to see two precious souls saved by the grace of God. Since we’ve been here in New England, we have been privileged to see more than 30 men and women ask Christ to save them. Bless His Name!! If you’d like to be involved in our next prison revival in November, please reach out. I’d love to have you get involved in the ministry here in New England. When most of you receive this letter, National Corrections Week 2023 will be in full swing. Lord willing, we plan to feed approximately 1,100 corrections staff the week of May 7-13, 2023. Please pray for us that everything will go smoothly and that God will be honored and glorified in this event. Thank you to everyone who gave to help with this. I’m constantly amazed at the blessings that God bestows upon us. Lord willing, when the event is over, I will produce a short video to give totals and show pictures of what God allowed us to do. This will be posted on our Facebook page. Thank you for your prayers and financial support for my family and me. If you don’t support us financially but would like to have a part in what God is allowing us to do here in New England, we would be honored to represent you, or your church, on the mission field here in New England! I still have some open dates available throughout the rest of the year if you’d like me to come by and give an update in person.
